Below is the information you requested regarding the certification status of this physician as of June 9, 2016. In addition to reporting board certification, ABIM will report whether or not ABIM Board Certified physicians are participating in MOC (i.e., engaging in MOC activities frequently). To be participating in MOC, a physician needs to be enrolled in the program, earn some MOC points every two years, 100 points every 5 years and take and pass an exam in his/her discipline every 10 years. Because ABIM's Maintenance of Certification (MOC) program requires continuous activities to maintain certification, ABIM will no longer issue certificates with end dates; however we recognize that some entities may still require current certification status to complete primary-source verification.

ABIM's website, abim.org/verify, is the primary verification source for ABIM Board Certification. We will be updating this status on an annual basis. Therefore, we encourage credentialers to utilize **ABIM's annual re-verification date of April 1** to verify your physician's status. By utilizing the annual re-verification date suggested, you will have accurate information about a diplomate's current certification status.
