

Patient Portal Sign Up and Consent Form

What is My Care Plus? My Care Plus is a secure, convenient website developed specifically for patients to have convenient access to their personal health records.

What will I be able to access? This patient-focused portal will give you anytime access to diagnosis information, therapies, lab results, allergies and medication lists.

Additional benefits: The portal includes a message center so that you can securely contact your Medical Team with questions or concerns. It will also give you the opportunity to share health information with family and caregivers.

Notice: Be assured that the Cancer Center of Kansas will not use the portal as a means to communicate with you about billing, scheduling, or any issue needing your immediate attention.

How Do I Sign Up?

Simply fill out the attached consent form and return to our front desk.



Once we have your consent form on file, we will notify My Care Plus and they will send you an email inviting you to enroll. Your email invite will provide you with a link and temporary passcode, with instructions prompting you to create your own personal user name and password. Please access the link within 7 days from the day you receive the email invitation, or it will expire.

Notice to Cox.net users:

- 1) Login to your email account and click on settings. You will be redirected to message settings.
- 2) Find "Mail Management" and under this, click on "spam blocker settings"
- 3) The default setting is set to the box which says, "automatically delete all unknown senders" UNCHECK THIS BOX
- 4) Now, check the box that says, "tag junk email with -spam- in the subject line and deliver to your inbox" which will enable you to receive My Care Plus emails.

*If you think you have received the email invitation prior to, check your SPAM folder and open the email from the Cancer Center of Kansas and click on "This is not spam".
